RUGBY AND ENGLISH FOUNDATION

In historic schools and in quiet and green areas of England and Ireland, during the entire month of July, we offer the opportunity to young international athletes to live totally immersed in the life of the best English and Irish colleges, and enjoy an effective method to learn the English language.

Athletes can live at college or stay with carefully selected host families, which will facilitate their learning process and improve their personal skills that help in communication.

RUGBY AND ENGLISH

"Play Rugby and Learn English" is an educational approach that allows students to learn English while they are participating in a specific rugby-training programme within a rugby academy. This method is recommended to all the students who wish to improve their English and develop their rugby skills. The Rugby and English programme is designed for athletes between the ages of 9 and 18 years old.

International participation

Participants come from all over the world, especially from France, Spain and Italy, and this ensures that the only communication code is English.

SCHOOLS AND SPORTS FACILITIES

The programme is implemented in universities and colleges with modern and excellent academic and sports facilities, situated in great locations around the world. All the schools have bright and spacious classrooms, equipped with modern teaching and learning facilities and safe Internet access. We are committed to provide all the international students with an appropriate, safe and secure learning and training environment.

The designated sports centres have a variety of pitches, courts and a wide range of other superb indoor and outdoor sport facilities, which offer students the perfect locations to train and play rugby or practice

many other sports such as basketball, volleyball, football, tennis, hockey, golf, pitch and putt, table tennis, swimming, horse riding, climbing, sailing and many more.

ENGLISH COURSE

English classes are made up of a maximum of 15 students per class plus native English speaking teachers, university graduated, that are highly experienced and fully qualified to teach English to international students (TEFL).

The English courses cover all aspects of the language: speaking, listening, reading, writing, grammar, vocabulary and pronunciation. The courses focus on conversations and debates keeping classes lively while enhancing oral fluency. Emphasis is also placed on written skills including letters, reports and emails writing.

There are 15 hours of English language tuition each week.

Courses can run over 2, 3 or 4 weeks.

ENGLISH PROGRAMME

Before the start of the course students are assessed with a placement test to determine their level of English. They are then placed in an appropriate class according to their level and needs and they will develop their language skills adopting the approach "from beginner (A1) to advanced (C1)". Our

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various phases of the acquisition of language skills. The English programme focuses on learning materials from established publishers combined with modern teaching methods, in order to attain promptly and effectively the objective of improved pronunciation and oral fluency.

CERTIFICATE

At the end the course a certificate of attendance is issued to each student. It certifies the number of hours studied, the progress that has been made and the level of English proficiency reached.

RECOGNITIONS

The Irish and the British departments of education recognize our educational programmes. Schools, English courses, teachers qualifications, teaching methods and techniques and learning experience are inspected, reviewed or approved by ACELS in Ireland and by the British Council in the United Kingdom.

RUGBY ACADEMY

The project has been generated in conjunction with the "Long-term player development programme", created by the Irish Rugby Football Union, which aims to maximise individual potential and involvement in rugby. This programme takes care of the rugby players, covering all aspects of coaching, nutrition, fitness and the spirit with which young athletes should be conducted during their training process as they progress along their rugby journeys. The athletes learn the essential techniques required to play safely, develop new skills and new ways to express themselves within a group. There will be the

“humbleness” that comes by playing for a team and the “responsibility” for the safety and enjoyment of all participants. We encourage a healthy competition and promote the joy to participate in rugby.

RUGBY COACHING

All participants are assisted and guided by highly qualified professional IRFU, RFU, WRU and NZRU coaches, experienced tutors, expert educators and former professional players. The coaching programme focus on all aspects of the game. Particular emphasis is placed on individual techniques and skills development, communication and the ability to make decisions. We have forwards and backs coaches; scrum instructors; coaches specialised in individual, mini-unit and team skills development; educators with expertise in team building and leadership development.

RUGBY PROGRAMME

The athletes will have more than 10 hours per week of training and interrelated activities, such as educational classes, position specific analysis tuition, coaching sessions on individual techniques; mental strength, intelligence and rugby skills development. There are also rugby matches and introduction to match analysis.

ACCOMMODATION (Residential and Host Family)

Students can live in a residential college or with selected host families, which have many years experience in hosting international students. The Interaction with the host family plays an important role in students' self-confidence and language skills development and at the same time gives the opportunity to make a great cultural experience. Host families are conveniently located to the schools. We are constantly in contact with each host family during the students' whole stay.

All meals are included.

PLEASE NOTE

The rugby academies are open to players of any level, ambition and nationality. Individual technique, basic skills development, teamwork and enjoyment will be considered fundamental aspects of the rugby programme. For those students who wish to learn English without taking part in a rugby academy, there are many other sports and cultural activities available, which involve professional educators and highly experienced coaches and instructors all committed to provide the students with the best possible education. The activities programmes give students the opportunities to explore and absorb new cultures, make new friends and improve and practice the English language outside the classroom in a fun and relaxed way.
